As the new year gains pace, global fresh produce markets reflect a healthy balance of continuity and transition. Northern and Southern Hemisphere supplies are aligning seamlessly—ensuring reliability, quality, and consistency across categories.

Berries: Egyptian strawberries are scaling up steadily, supporting smooth replenishment cycles.

Melons: Brazilian supply continues to anchor the category, ensuring continuity through the tropical cycle.

Grapes: Australian origins are now firmly established, offering reliable sizing and sweetness across red and green varieties.

Egyptian Citrus: Egyptian programs are delivering peak internal quality with strong color and juice ratios, supporting both retail and foodservice demand.

Stone Fruits: Southern Hemisphere supply is stabilizing, with South African orchards moving into a favorable quality window.

Two Seasons. One Intelligent Flow.

Fresh produce does not move in straight lines—it moves in rhythms.

As Northern Hemisphere orchards rest and Southern Hemisphere farms peak, the real challenge is not sourcing—but synchronization. The difference between freshness preserved and freshness compromised lies in timing, cold-chain discipline, and decision-making speed.

At NRTC, this orchestration happens long before harvest:

- Forecasting demand before fruit leaves the tree
- Aligning logistics to market velocity
- Protecting shelf life without over-cooling
- Transitioning origins without disrupting customers

This is not supply—it is supply intelligence. And it is how freshness travels seamlessly across seasons, borders, and markets.
